ROLE/ Key Accountabilities: To co-ordinate and administer Dover Rowing Club's development in line with the DRC development plan and report in to DRC Committee

- © Assist in running the ARA NJRP dry and wet start programme
- © Support DRC Coaching Development and Junior Development
- © Work with support group to deliver key outcomes of the programme
- © Co-ordinate existing instructors to successfully support DRC Junior development programme
- © Promote rowing in the region
- Assist South East Rowing Council (Coast) Coaching programme and coaches
- Assist all clubs in achieving compliance with ARA and CARA water safety requirements (inconjunction with CARA and club water safety advisors) and Child practice procedures

RESPONSIBILITIES

- They are to ensure all new members have the required training as laid down in the Club's safety induction programme.
- To sit on the Club's committee as an officer, reporting on coaching and junior development to committee.
- © To discuss and assist with training needs for junior members.
- © Be fully aware of the Water Safety Code of Practice and be able to advise members of the club when necessary.
- © To liase and represent Dover Rowing Club at CARA/BR/Educational and any other organisations as required on topics regarding junior coaching

SKILLS/KNOWLEDGE/EXPERIENCE REQUIRED

Ideally BR qualified Coach, but must be a good motivator of young people & women, communicate and have a rapport with these groups, and adaptable to coastal rowing conditions/requirement
